These are the driving forces behind the work of SCARF. Our role in the community is to provide support to refugee entrants in the Illawarra by creating connections that build a sense of belonging, promote social & economic inclusion, and empower individuals and families to lead independent lives. We offer the social and practical support needed to help rebuild their lives. Since 2005 we have been leaders in responsive settlement support through our 300-strong network of volunteers who generously offer their time, energy and expertise to deliver SCARF's activities and programs. More than 1800 people from refugee backgrounds - from 14 different countries of origin (Afghanistan, Burma, Burundi, Congo, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Iran, Iraq, Liberia, Palestine, Sierra Leone, Sudan, Syria, Togo) - have benefited from one or more SCARF services.

Our services include befriending; education and tutoring programs for primary, secondary and tertiary students; continuous learning activities for adults (eg. citizenship studies, job readiness support, CV-writing/interview skills); learner driver mentor program; youth leadership initiatives and social inclusion events.

Hand in Hand Art Exhibition

The Hand in Hand Art Exhibition is a significant cultural and community event hosted by SCARF. Formerly known as Art4Refugees this unique charity art exhibition is now in its 10th year and has become a highly anticipated annual event. Proceeds from the sale of donated artworks directly support SCARF programs for refugee children, youth and adults starting a new life in the Illawarra.


